

Troop 7
Nantucket Bike Trip
June 17 – 19, 2011



Fee:

\$40 per person. Pay at the June 8 Troop meeting. Permission slips required.

The schedule:

Wed, June 8, 6:45 pm

Scouts bring their bikes to the Troop meeting for a safety inspection. This is important! If something is amiss, you'll have a week to get it fixed.

Thurs, June 16, 7:00 pm

All camping gear and bikes go into a rented truck at the church.

Fri, June 17,

3:30 pm – Scouts and adults carpooling depart Scituate (we expect heavy cape traffic)

2:45 pm - The truck goes onto the Steamship Authority's big ferry from Hyannis to Nantucket.

5:30 pm - Scouts and adults **arrive at the HYLINE Ferry, 220 Ocean Street in Hyannis** (don't be late!)

6:00 pm – HYLINE ferry departs Hyannis

7:00 pm – HYLINE ferry arrives at Nantucket and we all meet at the truck near the dock. We unload the bikes (leaving the camping gear on the truck). Scouts and adults ride bikes a couple of miles to Camp Richard (the BSA campground on Nantucket.) Truck delivers all the gear to Camp Richard.

Sat, June 18,

Scouts who cannot make the Friday ferry will take an early Saturday morning ferry. (We must know this in advance.) Your bikes and an adult will meet you at the Nantucket dock.

The rest of the day, all scouts ride the trails on Nantucket and visit the beach.

Sun, June 19,

12:00 pm - Everybody (and the truck) on the big Steamship Authority ferry returning to Hyannis

2:15 pm – Everybody arrives at Hyannis

What to bring Thursday, June 16, to the truck:

Camping gear (more info at the June 8 meeting),

bike and gear (helmet required),

swimsuit and towel

(bring a SMALL daypack with you on the ferry for personal items)
